

Use of Cookies with PC Branch

A “cookie” is a small text file or text identifier placed on end users’ computers. Cookies are commonly used on websites and do not harm end users’ systems. All private data stored in cookies by our Internet Service provider are encrypted, and for internal use only. In order to tailor website content to our member’s interests, cookies must be accepted. All of our cookies are temporary, which means that they are active only as long as the customer’s browser is running and are deleted when the session has ended. Cookies must be enabled on the end user’s browser to enable proper functionality.
